We use indefinite articles
(a/an) when we are
mentioning something for the
first time or talking about
something that's not specific.
We use a before words starting
with a consonant and a before
words starting with a vowel (a,
e, i, o, u).

We use the definite article (the) when and our listener/reader already know which specific thing we're talking about-either because we're already mentioned it or because there is only one of it (e.g., with superlative adjectives). We also use it with the names of mountain rangers, rivers, seas, oceans, and groups of islands or stars.
