





# A life cycle is a series of changes, or stages, that all living organisms go through from the beginning of life until they die. The life cycles of plants, animals, and humans can be complex with many stages, or simpler with fewer stages.

A cycle is a sequence of events that repeat over and over again. Every living thing has a basic life cycle, with stages of birth, growth, and reproduction. However, life cycles can differ greatly from one species to another. Take for example a butterfly and a mankey. Although both are animals, they go through very different stages in their life cycles.

All living things will change and grow within their life cycle. Most organisms will reproduce when they are fully grown, leading the way to new life and starting the life cycle again.
