



Topic: Simple Past Tense

The past simple, also known as the simple past tense, is a verb tense used to describe actions that happened in the past.

Regular verbs

To form the past simple or regular verbs, add "-ed" to the end of the infinitive.

For example:

talk	becomes	talked
taik	becomes	taikea

Irregular verbs

This kind of verbs don't follow a specific pattern. Some take the same form as the infinitive, while others change completely.

For example:

wake	becomes	woke
