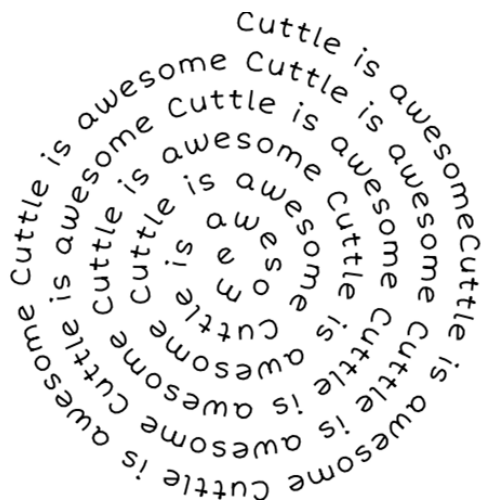

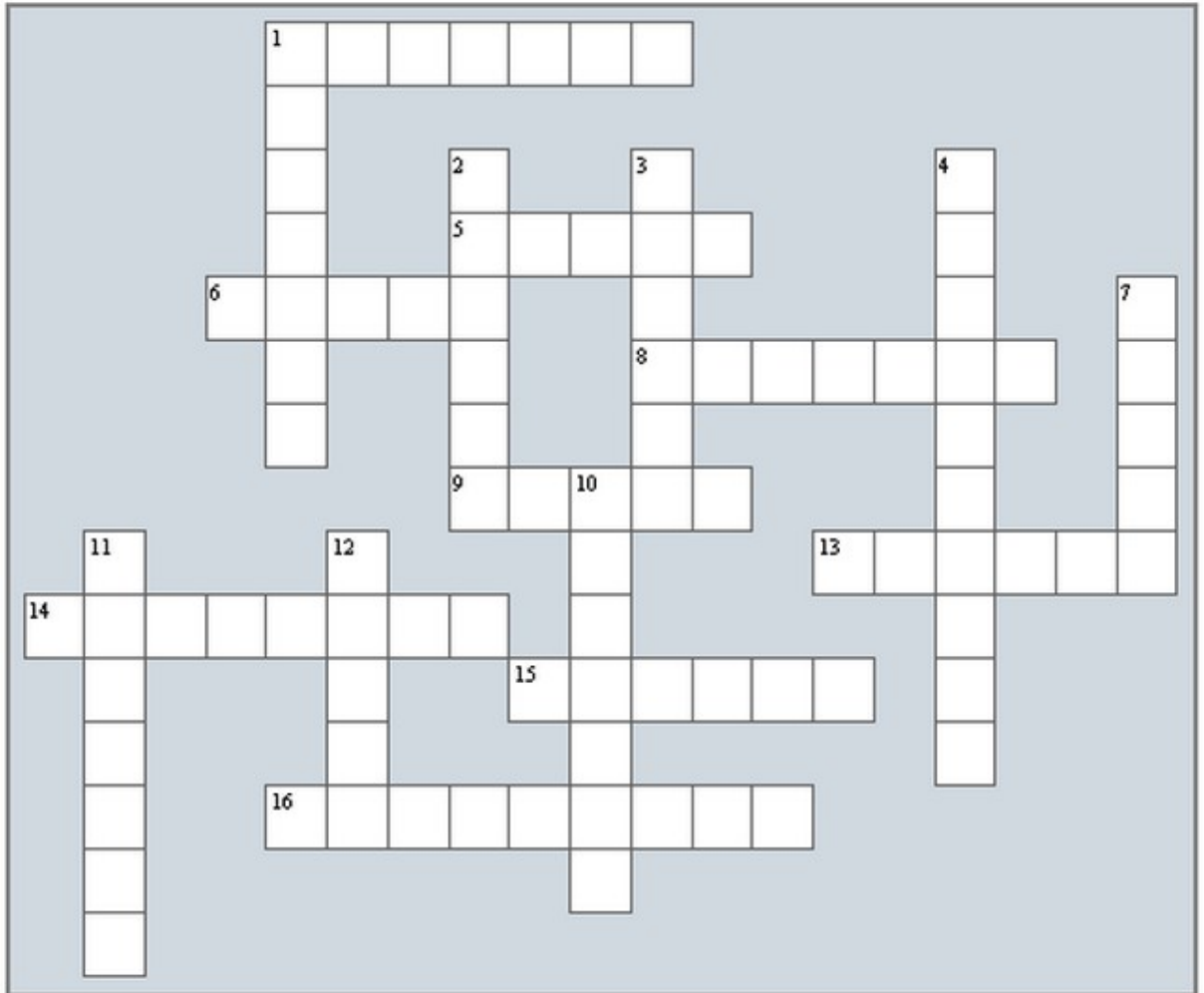

Topic: **Simple Past Tense**

The past simple, also known as the simple past tense, is a verb tense used to describe actions that happened in the past.

Regular verbs

To form the past simple or regular verbs, add “-ed” to the end of the infinitive.

For example:

talk	becomes	talked
------	---------	--------

Irregular verbs

This kind of verbs don't follow a specific pattern. Some take the same form as the infinitive, while others change completely.

For example:




wake	becomes	woke
------	---------	------

	structure	subject + verb in past + object
	examples	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● she visited the museum. ● they played soccer. ● I studied for the exam.
	structure	subject + didn't + verb in base form + object
	examples	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● she didn't visit the museum. ● they didn't play soccer. ● I didn't study for the exam.
	structure	Did + subject + verb in base form + object + ?
	examples	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Did she visit the museum? ● Did they play soccer? ● Did you study for the exam?
