The student will use their creativity to make a cardboard presentation about **“The story of Chocolate”** from the Cambridge book, pages 97-98. Be creative!

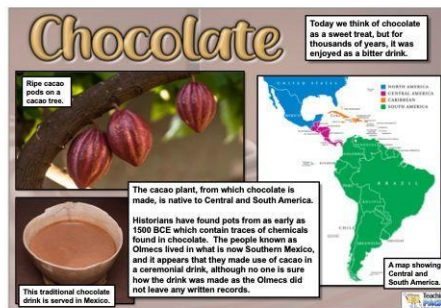
Speech example:
